2020 CSCC Conference Cancellation FAQs

I already registered for the conference. Will I get my money back?

If you paid the registration fee for the 2020 conference, then you have two options. You may cancel your registration and ask for a refund by contacting csc@education.illinois.edu or you can allow your refund to be rolled over and applied to our next convening. If you do not request a refund by **March 31**, then your registration fee will automatically be rolled over. **Membership fees are not refundable.**

What about my hotel reservations?

Cancellations for lodging arrangements made for the CSCC Conference are the responsibility of attendees.

What about my airline reservations?

Please contact your airline carrier directly to inquire about any cancellation fees associated with your flight. CSCC is not responsible for travel reservations.

My proposal was accepted for this year's conference. What happens now?

Presentations **will not** be rolled over to next year's conference. Each conference has a different theme and different anonymous reviewers. You may opt to resubmit your presentation when the Call for Proposals for our next convening is shared, but acceptance is not guaranteed.
