2021 CSCC Membership and Conference Registration Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

When and where will the conference take place?

The 2021 CSCC Annual Conference will take place *virtually* April 15-17, 2021.

How can I register? What are the registration rates?

To register for the 2021 CSCC Annual Conference, please complete the CSCC Membership and Conference Registration form via the [online portal](#). Please note, you must have a paid 2021 CSCC membership to take advantage of the 2021 conference registration member rates listed below. If you are a current 2020 member, you must renew your membership for 2021. Registration includes access to the entire conference, including preconference sessions.

What does membership include?

CSCC bimonthly communications, discounted conference rates, member access to conference proceedings, CSCC- sponsored webinars, and voting privileges (only CSCC members may nominate others for CSCC awards and all nominees are required to be current CSCC members).



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Am I eligible for the member rate? How can I become a member?

You must be a 2021 CSCC member to be eligible for conference member rates. All 2021 CSCC memberships expire on 12/31/2021. If you have a question about your membership status, please email csc@education.illinois.edu.

I opted to roll over my 2020 conference registration fee. How do I use my credit?

You will receive a unique, one-time-use code for the amount of your credit to input in the appropriate field on the online registration form. The credit will then apply to your total charges. If there is a remaining credit, you can elect to donate it to the Graduate Student Registration Fund or apply it towards your 2022 CSCC membership fees.

How can I submit payment for membership and/or conference registration fees?

Payments for CSCC membership and/or 2021 conference registration can be made by credit card via the CSCC Membership and Conference Registration [online portal](#).

This year there is an option to indicate that your institution or organization will pay on your behalf. The prompt will read, **"If your institution will provide payment, check the box below and click Save". Then after you click 'Save', the top of the form will read: Registration Not Complete. Your information has been saved, but your registration will not be complete until payment is submitted at the bottom of this form. Please forward this URL to your payer to return to this form and provide payment.** Please note that you are not registered until payment is complete.

NOTE: CSCC is NOT accepting membership or conference registration fees by check or mail. All fees must be paid via the online membership and registration portal.

What is the cancellation and refund policy for the conference?

To cancel a conference registration and request a refund, send a request to csc@education.illinois.edu no later than 30 days before the conference (i.e., March 15, 2021) that includes "Refund Request" in the subject line. Include the reason for the refund and all contact information. The executive officers will review all requests on a case-by-case basis and send a reply and/or a refund within 60 days of receiving the request. Refund requests received within 30 days of the conference will not be considered under any circumstances. Any conference registrations received after March 15, 2021, are nonrefundable. Membership is nonrefundable.
